 \bigstar You have to register with TUAT twice a year, at the beginning of April and October



The method of recommendation

After you submit the documents to your school office, screening takes place on the other day (document screening, interviewing, study report, presentation, etc...). TUAT decide the order of priority from the result of this screening, and then TUAT recommends students to Private Foundations in the order of ascending priorities. X The applicant may have to take an interview at Private Foundation.



<u>Notice</u>

- ① We can not assure that you can receive a scholarship even if you register with TUAT and you get recommendation from TUAT.
- 2 You can not receive scholarships from two foundations at the same year.
- 3 You can know your place on the ranking list in T.U.A.T. for recommendation.
- (4) As of Oct 1, 2009, Privately Financed International Students who are enrolled in TUAT can register for this scholarship system in TUAT.
- (5) At this term, you also can apply for Japanese Government (Monbukagakusyo) scholarship. If you would like to apply it, please receive the documents which are exclusively for Japanese Government scholarship at your school office. If TUAT recommend you to Japanese Government, we exclude you from the ranking list for recommendation of Private Foundations.

(6) There are other kinds of scholarships which you do not need recommendation from TUAT. You can apply directly for it. Please get its information, see Private Foundation's Home Page and check the detail by yourself.
