Regarding Cash Handout of JPY 100,000-Per-Person to All Residents of Japan based on Japanese Government's "Emergency Economic Measures for Response to COVID-19"

(This cash handout is not related to the TUAT scholarships and does not affect the selection process, etc. of the scholarships provided by the University.)

As part of economic response to coronavirus outbreak, "Emergency Economic Measures for Response to COVID-19" (adopted by the Cabinet on April 20, 2020), this fixed-amount cash handout program is planned to be implemented in order to support households financially with quick and simple procedures whilst containing the spread of the infection. Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan has requested the universities to inform their students about this program. If you are eligible, be sure to apply and receive the cash handout.

O Every person listed on Japan's Basic Resident Register as of April 27, 2020 is eligible.

(The head of the household is the person to apply to this program on behalf of all the family members in the household and to receive 100,000 yen for each eligible person in the household)

- % If you have moved your resident register from your family and is currently living by yourself, you need to apply as you are the head of the_household.
- Foreign nationals residing in Japan listed on the Basic Resident Register as of April 27, 2020 are also eligible. (Please contact International Affairs Office *tuat-international-office*m2.tuat.ac.jp* if you have any question regarding the application. Replace * with @)
- Students who have returned to Japan after studying abroad and residing in Japan as of April 27, 2020 (Japanese students, etc.) are also eligible.

(Procedure to revitalize your resident register is required. It is also possible to apply for revitalization of your resident register after April 27, 2020.)

- Municipalities have sent or will send application forms by mail to the heads of every household.
 Applicants will apply via mail or online (online application is available to "My Number Card" (individual identification system) holders).
- O In principle, all the money for that household will be **transferred to the bank account of the applicant.**

• The application is accepted for a period of 3 months from the application acceptance date (by mail) set by each municipality.

Be Careful of fraud regarding cash handout

Any personnel from the municipalities, Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications of Japan, or the Japanese government, etc. will ask you to use ATM, nor will request you to transfer handling fees for this cash handout.
