Regarding Lecture Conducting Methods from 2020 Third Quarter

Considering the current situation that the spread of COVID-19 has not reached its global convergence, we announced that for the lectures in which infection prevention measures can be taken such as ones that can avoid the three conditions (3 Cs: closed spaces, crowds, and close contact), face-to-face lectures will be offered wherever possible; for the others, lectures will continue to be offered online during the 2020 third and fourth quarters at TUAT.

Regarding the detailed schedules and conducting methods of each course, each faculty/graduate school/united graduate school will inform you through the Web Bulletin Board for students, TUAT website, etc., as soon as the information is ready.

All TUAT students should be aware of the following contents: the policies of the faculty/graduate school/united graduate school you belong to; the guidelines, etc. provided by the national and related local governments; as well as the TUAT's Notice and Code of Conduct, etc. posted on the University website. We also request that our students take actions not to spread the infection, such as protecting yourselves from the virus and preventing infection transmission to others.

For those students who wish to refrain from coming to Tokyo or attending school due to concerns about the infection, we will take account of the situation if possible (such as by sending lecture video clips to the student online), so please contact a member of education committee or your advising professor. In addition, for those with various concerns such as on course planning, or for those having a hard time emotionally or financially, the University provides several student support systems through your advising professors, supervisors, student life committees, student support offices, counselors, Health Service Center, etc., so please do not hesitate to contact us and discuss any concern you have.
