Implementation Policies for Lectures, etc. from October

Our continuous and utmost attention must be paid to preventing the spread of the novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19). However, on the other hand, vaccination opportunities for students have gradually increased; and we, at TUAT, expect that vaccination for all students would be completed by around October (for those who had wished to be vaccinated).

Based on this current situation, our implementation policies for lectures, etc. from October are as follows. To create an environment where lectures and research - the first priority of the university - can be conducted, we ask all students to raise your awareness on "protecting yourself from infection and preventing infection transmission to others". We also ask you to continue to cooperate in preventing the virus spread by strictly following basic epidemic prevention measures such as wearing masks; and by refraining from gathering to eat or drink with others regardless of whether it is in a restaurant or in your own house/residence, etc. In addition, please consider getting vaccinated early before lectures start in October.

- Take actions to prevent the virus spread such as by taking care of your physical condition, hand washing and wearing masks. If you feel unwell, please consult a doctor, etc., and do not attend university nor go outside the house/residence.
- We ask all student and lectures to wear a mask during lectures as a rule (except for the following cases: where someone cannot wear a mask due to inevitable reason(s) or where a lecturer instructs certain individual(s) to take their mask off).
- Lecture courses and experiment/practical training/research courses will be conducted face to face to the possible extent. Details will be announced by the Faculty or Graduate School you belong to. Please check the student Web Bulletin Board and TUAT website, etc. frequently for updates.
- Laboratory activities can be carried out after thorough infection prevention measures are taken. However, please ensure to follow the policies of the Faculty or Graduate School you belong to.
- As we will be frequently posting up-to-date information on how the events, such as the student health checkup or orientations, will be held at TUAT, please check the student Web Bulletin Board and TUAT website, etc.
- Please make use of the textbook online orders through the Univ. Co-op.
- At each campus, infection prevention measures are taken and we are working to create a safe
 environment for study and research, where the students and researchers can pursue their study
 and research without much concern about the infection transmission, etc. Please cooperate in
 wearing masks, cleaning your hands and disinfecting your desks with alcohol, etc.
- If you are concerned about attending university due to traffic congestion, etc. when you commute to university, please contact your supervisor/advising professor or the student committee member.
