Regarding the change of semester system

Globalization is progressing rapidly in higher education, and we think that study abroad is a valuable opportunity for all students. With this in mind, from FY2019, we will change our curriculum system from the 2 semester system to the 4 semester system. In the second and the fourth semesters, the regular classes (fixed weekly lessons) can be avoided so that students can use this time to travel abroad for study. In concrete terms, the first and second semesters will be from April 1st to September 30th (the first half), and the third and fourth semesters will be from October 1st to March 31st of the following year (the second half). Please keep in mind that the first and the third semesters are mainly for regular classes and the second and fourth semesters shall be used mainly as the period recommended for study abroad, intensive lectures and etc.
